The Mexico Section of the IES introduces its first Call for Speakers to lighting professionals interested in participating in the 14th International Lighting Journey to be held on June 6 – 8, in Mexico City.

The Lighting Journey has been a very successful event for over 13 years where lighting design professionals and experts from the industry share their expertise in state of the art lighting applications, technology, education and lighting science.

ThemeThe general theme for the 13th Lighting Journey will be: "Light, Ecology and Human Being, inseparable Trinomial in the integration of Lighting Systems". The goal of this year's edition is to create awareness about the need quality lighting design that focuses on human needs and sustainable practices above the use of any specific technology .

Proposals are required to address this idea and to explain different approaches in design applications where aesthetics, technology and overall good design coexist symbiotically.

ProposalsFor the proposals the following information is required:

1. Seminar title
 2. Course description (200 words, outlining the topic)
 3. Three learning objectives.
- Presentation method.

RequirementsConsidering the educational mission of the Society those seminars, those proposal which are focused on commercial objectives and/or containing promotional information or brands, will be discarded. In any case where the presentation includes images or technical references to specific products, the commercial information –brand, logos, advertisement, etc. – must be removed.

All seminars should last 75 minutes including at least 10-15 minutes for a Q&A session.

Please submit your proposal with your personal information and bio. Your previous experience as speaker is very important.

BenefitsIn a professional level, the Lighting Journey is an excellent opportunity for speakers to present their ideas and knowledge to an active and specialized lighting community open to networking and collaboration.

Speakers will receive the following from the Mexico Section of the IES:



1. Tourist class round flight ticket from your place of residence to Mexico City. The Mexico Section of the IES will arrange booking and advance payment.
2. The Lighting Journey Committee will assign a personal host (a member of the Section) who will take care of ground transportation and food expenses for each speaker.
3. Up to three hotel nights in a 5 star facility, single room.
4. Full pass to the Conference, approximately \$200.00 USD value.
